NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY!!

I. General Rules and Regulations

The most important rule: ***If there is a contamination of any type, the pool area will be immediately locked down and closed until further notice.***

- **No children under 16 years of age may enter the pool area unless accompanied by an individual 18 years old or older.**
- Any guest to the pool must be accompanied by a resident. All persons should be able to identify themselves if so requested. This is necessity to assure use of the pool only by residents (and their authorized guests) and to track and deter rule violations. **A maximum of 2 guests are allowed per resident.**
- Proper swimming attire is required. Children under the age of 3 years are required to wear rubber pants (not swim diapers or regular diapers). This will be enforced to the max for the safety of everyone.
- Absolutely **NO GLASS** or breakable objects are permitted inside the fenced-in area of the pool.
- **Absolutely no running, diving, boisterous or rough play will be permitted** in the pool enclosure or lavatories.
- Splashing, shoving, dunking is not permitted. Spitting, spouting of water, blowing the nose, etc., in the pool is strictly prohibited.
- Profanity, foul and disrespectful language, improper behavior, intoxication, and vulgar remarks are prohibited and may result in ejection from the pool grounds. We reserve the right to restrict pool use of any individual whose behavior endangers the safety and well being of other swimmers.
- **No food, alcohol or glass containers.**
- Smoking is not permitted around the pool. Use the designated smoking area.
- Bicycles, skateboards and roller blades are not allowed in the pool area.
- Solitary swimming is not advised. Swim at your own risk.
- One person at a time on pool ladders.
- No playing with emergency equipment. These are not toys!
- Bathers shall take a cleaning shower before entering the pool and before returning to the pool following use of the toilet.
- Chewing gum in the water is prohibited.
- All trash should be disposed of in proper containers.
- Pets are not allowed on all Trident properties including the pool area.
- First aid equipment will be made accessible to adults. It will be mounted in plain view.
- The playing of radios, tapes, or CD's must be kept at a moderate noise level. The use of earphones is greatly appreciated.
- Upper arm floats are not considered lifesaving devices and children wearing these require strict parental supervision.
- **STORMS:** Please evacuate the pool area at the first sign of threatening weather.
- **Only 1 pool key will be issued to each apartment.** There will be a \$40 charge for replacement or loss of a pool key.
- Residents must return pool key(s) at lease end with all the other keys.

II. CONSEQUENCES FOR VIOLATION OF RULES

- 1st OFFENSE - Verbal warning and possible suspension of pool privileges for the day.
- 2nd OFFENSE - A letter will be sent and a one week suspension.
- 3rd OFFENSE - A letter will be sent and termination of pool privileges for remainder of pool season for the offender.
